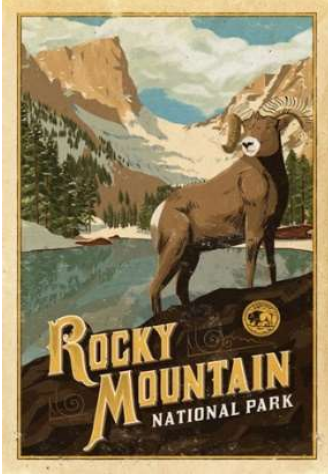

Campground Rules

Visitors: Every person, pet, and car must be registered in front office BEFORE entering.

Speed Limit: Please keep your speed under 5 mph.

Quiet Hours: 10 pm to 7 am.

Pets: Please attend to your pets and scoop the poop. Campers with aggressive dogs may be asked to find other accommodations. Well behaved pets are always warmly welcomed. All dogs must remain on leash. Retractable leashes are acceptable but must be reeled in to a 6 ft. length when near other campers with or without other dogs. Any aggressive animal behavior will be met with swift action to protect the safety of all campers and their pets. Aggressive behavior includes excessively barking, growling, baring teeth, biting, etc. If your dog displays aggression towards other dogs or campers, 1) we will have to ask you to confine your dog to your camping unit, 2) leave the campground (any refunds will be at the managers discretion). The safety of everyone is our first concern.

Vehicles: One vehicle is included with your registration fee. [Additional parking is available at the Visitors Center.](#)

Children: Be sure your children are supervised when around the campground and on the playground equipment.

Cabin Early Morning Departure:

If leaving early in the morning, drop your key through the **night drop opening to the right of the front office door.**



Cabin Departure Checklist: Use the yellow departure list posted near the door of your cabin. Remove all food and trash to the dumpster. A \$100 fee will be charged for an excessively dirty or damaged cabin. Check out time is 11 a.m.

Cigarette Smoking: No smoking allowed in any campground building, Cabin and Deluxe Cabin. There a \$250 fee for smoking in our cabins. Please dispose of your spent cigarettes responsibly.

Marijuana:

While marijuana is legalized in the State of Colorado, we are a private campground and therefore we can ban (and do) the use of marijuana . If a camper is using marijuana, please see anyone in a yellow KOA shirt or call the night phone to make us aware of the problem. We will ask the camper to stop using immediately . If the camper chooses not to comply, they will be removed from the campground without refund.

Restrooms/Showers: Our restrooms and showers are for registered guests only.

Food /Garbage Storage: We have badgers, raccoons, coyotes, red fox, bobcat and black bear in the neighboring mountains and forests. Store your food and garbage inside locked cars or locked cabins. Garbage in dumpsters is locked with bear bar between 7 and 8 pm.

EV Charging: We do not allow for EV charging on the campground. There are numerous charging sites in town. Please visit them online at <https://estespark.colorado.gov/electricvehicles>. Because of the potential damage to our campground's electrical grid from EV charging, we will impose a \$100 fine for campers charging their EV on the campground.

Laundry Room:

Open 6 am- 10 pm. \$3.00 wash and \$1.50 dry per load.

Often two loads of wash can go into one dryer.

Soap, dryer sheets etc. is available in the store.

Quarters are available from our front desk staff.



WI-FI:

Wi-Fi/Internet service is free to registered campers.

Wi-Fi is intended for light surfing and checking emails and is NOT Intended for online gaming and video streaming.

Please help keep everyone's Wi-Fi "fast". Do not stream or game.

Outgoing mail: put into the **LOON MAILBOX** inside the store.

FREE Shuttle Service:

July 1st through Labor Day.

Stand at the shelter near the end of the driveway. It will take you to the Visitor's Center and from there you can grab another per your destination!

The shuttle comes 2x/hour: at 9 minutes and at 39 minutes

For example: 10:09 am & 10:39 am

Ask the front desk staff for a shuttle schedule to see where you can travel without your car.

Mountain Vacationing

Estes Park is a high mountain valley at 7,500 ft.

Popular trails and waterfalls within Rocky Mountain National Park can be from 8,000-11,000 feet.

At this altitude we suggest you wear a hat, sunglasses, and use a high SPF sunscreen. Be aware of signs of altitude sickness: **headaches, fatigue, faintness.**

Take your time, drink a lot of water, wear sturdy shoes.

Pets need extra water even when at the campsite.
